Area 1 Spotlight: The Boston Handbell Festival

Now in its fifteenth year, the Boston Handbell Festival is an annual celebration of handbell musicianship co-sponsored by two Area 1 handbell organizations: the Back Bay Ringers and the Old South Ringers. The Boston Handbell Festival proudly contributes to a musical tradition of handbell ringing at Old South Church that dates back to 1929.

The Boston Handbell Festival brings together local community handbell ensembles-the Back Bay Ringers, Merrimack Valley Ringers, New England Ringers, and Old South Ringers-along with an invited guest choir each year. On May 16,





The concert is always free and open to the public, and a free-will offering is collected to sustain the Festival and to support a Chime Donation program, whereby a 2-octave set of Malmark Choirchimes® is donated to a greater-Boston-area school. The 2023 Choirchimes® recipient was Mansfield High School.
