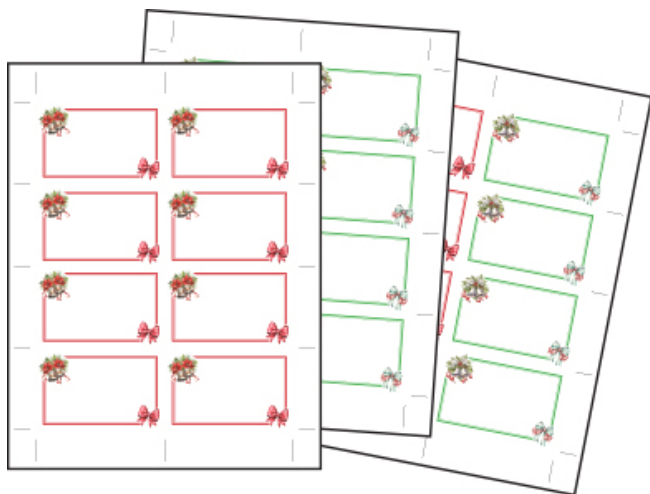


Jingle Bell Place Card

Here is a quick and easy place card you can make for an upcoming holiday dinner using a jingle bell, some ribbon, and the included printable name card templates



Fold the ribbon to a point so that you can thread it through the loop on the bottom of the bell. Using a wider ribbon will help keep the bell more stable on the table. Note: The bell will lean slightly, so place it so that it leans toward the back.



The downloads include two motifs: one red, one green, and one with both to mix and match. You can print as is and write names by hand or place them in Word or a layout program to add text. The templates are compatible with Avery name badge No. 5390 or print on plain card stock and cut out according to the guides in the margins.



Place the bell at the guest's spot and slip the name card into the slot. If you don't want to assign places, you might simply add holiday sentiments or ice-breaker trivia questions to the cards. Use your imagination. After dinner, the bells (with their ribbon handles) make nice party favors. Maybe encourage your guests to ring them in order to make a toast.
