The Diversity Discussion Series will continue in 2027 at National Seminar in Albuquerque in July, with a new topic to be determined from survey results from our constituents. The survey link will be shared in a weekly email and on our website. We will also host an online session on this topic in fall 2027.

The information shared with you in this article is just a snapshot of what we are doing to continually engage underrepresented communities with our instrument and organization.
